GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Heart of Brooklyn is seeking Junior Counselors to assist leading youth ages 7–12 during three, 2-week sessions of the **Brooklyn Cultural Adventures Program (BCAP) Summer Camp**: an innovative day camp that weaves exciting connections between art, science, culture and nature—all in fun and educational settings.
